2018 IRS TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT / W-2 FORMS MAY BE OBTAINED BY CONTACTING THE IRS - SEE INFORMATION BELOW:

- ➤ Get Transcript by Mail Go to www.irs.gov, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript by Mail." Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript." The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the online request.
- ➤ <u>Get Transcript Online</u> Go to www.irs.gov, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript Online." Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript." To use the Get Transcript Online tool, the user must have (1) access to a valid email address, (2) a text-enabled mobile phone (pay-as-you-go plans cannot be used) in the user's name, and (3) specific financial account numbers (such as a credit card number or an account number for a home mortgage or auto loan). The transcript displays online upon successful completion of the IRS's two-step authentication.
- ➤ <u>Automated Telephone Request</u> Call the IRS's automated telephone order line at 1-800-908-9946. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request. Listen carefully to the prompts.
- ➤ <u>Paper Request Form</u> IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. Submit the request(s) in to CWC and we will fax it to the IRS for you. The transcript should arrive within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form.
